The research work is conducted in the following areas: processing of various plant materials and their by-products into higher added value components by innovative high pressure fractionation, enzyme-assisted and ultrasound-assisted extraction techniques, functional characterization of the products obtained and course and control of non-enzymatic browning reactions by plant bioactives.
