

Dr. Nijolė Zinkevičienė

Dr. Nijole Zinkeviciene holds a PhD in Social Sciences (Educational Science) from Kaunas University of Technology for the doctoral thesis "Manifestation of teacher's rational receptivity to pedagogical innovations in the aspect of non-university higher education". She is a Vice-Rector for Research and Partnerships at Vilniaus kolegija/University of Applied Sciences, the largest and leading professional higher education institution in Lithuania. Previously she worked for ten years at Kauno kolegija/Kaunas University of Applied Sciences as a Vice-Rector for studies and research.

From 2010 to 2016 Nijole Zinkeviciene was a member of the national Bologna experts group and a member of the Commission of International Studies at the Educational Exchanges Support Foundation of Lithuania. From 2012 to 2018 she was a member of the Higher Education Institutions' Evaluation Committee at the Centre for Quality Assessment in Higher Education (Lithuania). From 2014 to 2018 she acted as the editor-in-chief of the journal "Mokslo taikomieji tyrimai Lietuvos kolegijose"("Applied Research at the Colleges of Lithuania") (ISSM 1822-7244). From 2016 to 2019 she was a member of the Steering Committee of UASnet (Universities of Applied Sciences network). Since 2014 she is the head of the R&D Committee at the Lithuanian College Directors' Conference. Since 2018 Nijole Zinkeviciene belongs to the EURASHE (European Association of Institutions in Higher Education) working group on Research, Development and Innovation. Since 2019 she is a member of EURASHE Board.
