Assoc. Prof. Dr. Vitalija Bartuševičienė graduated from the Vilnius Pedagogical Institute with a degree in History and Pedagogy (1991) and a Master's degree in Social Sciences (Education) from Kaunas University of Technology (1998). In 2002, she defended a doctoral dissertation in Social Sciences (Education) at Kaunas University of Technology.

Since 2002, she has been working as an Associate Professor at the Departments of Social Welfare, Law, Business and Public Management at Utena College. Since 2009 she has been the Deputy Director for Science and Development of Utena College. From 2018, she is the Deputy Director for Studies and Science of Utena College.

Vitalija Bartuševičienė worked in the Bologna Process Expert Group (2004–2006), in the Bologna Follow-up Group under the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Lithuania (2012–2017), participated in the work of Utena Region Strategic Document Preparation Groups (2013–2017), expert in higher education study programmes and professional development programs and strategic documents.
