An art critic, cultural manager, expert in cultural policy and creative industries

After graduating with a Master's degree in art history and theory from the Vilnius Academy of Arts, she worked for many years as an organizer and curator of art exhibitions, and for ten years she managed the gallery of the Lithuanian Artists' Union. In 2008 together with the British Council, she began working with UK NGOs to grow her experiences in the field of *art for health*. Since 2009, when she prepared the project "Art Territory" for the national program "Vilnius - European Capital of Culture 2009", she has been organizing social art projects, creative workshops, initiating activities at Vilnius University Children's Hospital. She is acting as a mediator for creative partnerships between artists and health and social services, initiate political dialogue and interinstitutional cooperation.
