



## **Dr. Milda Žukauskienė**

Dr. Milda Žukauskienė graduated with a bachelor's degree in physiotherapy in 1997 and in 1999 finished her Master's studies in physiotherapy at the Lithuanian Sports University (then Lithuanian Academy of Physical Education). 2011 she defended her doctoral dissertation in social sciences (education) at Vytautas Magnus University with the topic "Curriculum modelling of the physiotherapy professional education".

Since 2000 works at Vilniaus Kolegija / University of Applied Sciences, she is head of Rehabilitation Department, a member of the Academic Council of Vilniaus Kolegija, the chair of the physiotherapy study program committee, a member of the occupational therapy study program committee. Participates in scientific projects in Lithuania and abroad.

Milda is a member of working groups at the Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education, Science and Sport of the Republic of Lithuania; is a member of the editorial board of the journal Social Health (ISSN 2351-6062); 2005-2013 was an Executive board member of ENPHE – European Network of Physiotherapy in Higher Education; is a member of the Board of the Lithuanian Physiotherapy Association.

Consistently participates in internships and conferences in Europe, gives lectures at foreign universities, prepares scientific articles, reads reports at conferences, participates in trainings.

Since 2010 she has been participating as an expert in the evaluation of study programs in Lithuania, in the evaluation of study programs and institutions in Latvia (2015) and Georgia (2017), at the University of Malta - as an expert in the final qualification examinations commission - as an external evaluator (2015; 2016). In 2018 joined the activities of the Higher Education Study Evaluation Commission.
